



VOTE!



No decision should be made about you, without you.

In California, most citizens can vote!

You CAN vote if:

- You are 18 years or older on the day of the election.
- You are a U.S. Citizen.
- If you are on probation or PRCS - you **CAN** vote.
- If you are serving a jail sentence - you **CAN** vote. (You can vote by mail in jail - and some jails set up polling stations.)
- If you have a conviction (felony or misdemeanor) - you **CAN** vote.

You cannot vote if:

- You are currently **servng a prison sentence** - either in state prison, federal prison, or serving a prison sentence in a jail.
- You are currently on **state parole**.
- You were found mentally incompetent *and* disqualified from voting by a court.
