

California Voting!



Eligibility Requirements:

- A United States citizen and a resident of California,
- 18 years old or older on Election Day,
- Not currently in state or federal prison or on parole for the conviction of a felony and
- Not currently found mentally incompetent to vote by a court.

Dates & Deadlines:

- Deadline to Register: October 19th
- Election Day: Nov. 3rd, 2020

Do I need Photo ID to vote? If you registered without a Drivers license #, Cal ID #, or SSN, then you will need to show some form of ID the first time you vote (you should not need to show ID after that).

Do I need a permanent address in order to vote? No, when you register to vote, you will have an option to list, "I do not have a street address" when you register.

Can I vote by mail? Yes, in California you can vote by mail in any election as long as you sign up to vote by mail when you register.

South Carolina Voting!



Eligibility Requirements:

A United States citizen and a resident of South Carolina,
18 years old or older on Election Day,

Not currently in state or federal prison or on parole or probation for the conviction of a felony or in county jail for the conviction of a misdemeanor

Not currently hospitalized involuntarily because you've been found incompetent.

Dates & Deadlines:

- Deadline to Register: October 5th (postmarked). In person on October 2nd. Email/fax on October 4th.
- Election Day: Nov. 3rd, 2020

Do I need Photo ID to vote? No, but it will make it a lot easier. You can get a free photo ID when you register.

Do I need a permanent address in order to vote? No, when you register to vote, you will have options to use addresses like a shelter, friend's house, etc.

Can I vote by mail? Yes, for certain reasons (and possibly for all depending on proposed legislation and pending litigation).
